Our ministry was blessed in so many ways in 2017. Our Lord orchestrated all that was needed for the FMM team to connect Jesus to a growing number ... in turn the Holy Spirit grew eternal fruit in the form of changed lives ... leading to changed families ... resulting in changed communities. Our staff, volunteers and suppoters are part of that blessing ... we thank the Lord for calling them to His mission ... we THANK all who pray, volunteer and financially support the work of FMM!

Some of the highlights were:

- Distributed over 12,600 Bibles
- Over 125,000 self-study Bible lessons were corrected by our staff and volunteers.
- The number of volunteers serving in the 33 FMM county jail missions exceeded 2,200 persons.
- Due to retirements, new chaplains were appointed in Kent, Bay and Roscommon county jails.
- New missions were launched in Midland (200 inmate capacity / 4,780 bookings per year) and Clare (178 inmate capacity / 4,300 bookings per year) county jails. Both are growing very nicely under the leadership of energetic chaplains.
