One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us the opportunity to look back and be thankful for all that the Lord has accomplished using the hands and feet of the Forgotten Man Ministries team. Some of the highlights were:

- Distributed over 13,500 Bibles
- Over 16,000 self-study Bible course were successfully completed by inmates
- The number of volunteers serving in the 34 FMM county jail missions exceeded 2,200 persons.
- Due to retirements, new chaplains were appointed in ten counties.
- New missions were launched in Van Buren County (215 inmate capacity)
